

Notes from PCC meeting held on
16 January 2012

The Rector and 19 members of the council attended
The matters discussed included the quinquennial inspections and what reports we need for Paul Vipond, who had been appointed the inspector for all three centre. The Archdeacon at his inspection felt that the Church Centre should be included in the architect's inspection. It is hoped to mend the heating at Emmanuel Holcombe, and several quotes have been received. Having paid the parish share in full in 2011, the parish may be eligible for grants.. A Legacy was received last year will also be put towards the cost. The treasurer spoke to the accounts, we currently have a working balance of unreserved funds of around £6300.00. Parish share has gone up again and we pay this off monthly but it takes about £4800.00 per month. The lent Course will be The Power of the Cross. This will be held at St Mary's quieter than the Church Centre, preceded by soup and bread. On Ash Wednesday at 7.00pm it will start with Soup, 7.30pm Service and then go into the course. Thanks were given to Chris Jamieson who has now finished his placement with us.
