Parish Share & Gift Aid - A note from the Treasurer

We have agreed with the Diocese our Parish Share for 2020 of £47,000. This is a 4% increase on last year. The Parish Share is used to fund Diocese activities and in particular clergy stipends. One of the main ways we raise contributions is through the Gift Aid scheme. For every £1 donated, we can claim back from the Government 25p, if the donation is Gift Aided by a taxpayer. We will be asking for new Gift Aid forms to be signed over the next few weeks as many of the original forms were damaged in a recent flood. David Lomax.
